

## **Anti-Bullying Charter**

Bullying is the persistent threatening, intimidation or harming of another by an individual or a group. It can take the following form:

- Verbal bullying
- Physical bullying
- Interfering with or taking another student's property
- Circulating rumours about a fellow-student
- Writing or sending unsavoury Text- messages, notes or phone calls to another with the intention of hurting that person.
- Ostracising or isolating a student

All these forms of bullying are totally unacceptable in the Abbey School and will not be tolerated.

We believe that each student has the right to an education free from fear, annoyance and intimidation.

We should all support each other by reporting any incidents of bullying we come across or suspect.

Any student who feels threatened in any way should inform his Parents, the Principal, Deputy-Principal or any teacher or use the suggestion box outside the Secretary's office.

All reports of bullying will be investigated and dealt with immediately

We all share the responsibility that bullying is not tolerated in our school.
